I. INTRODUCTION

The Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority (THEA) is soliciting sealed bids from qualified firms to provide all the labor, equipment, materials, tools, transportation, supplies, insurance, incidentals, mobilization, demobilization and maintenance of traffic necessary to provide video inspection of certain storm drain pipes, manholes and inlets on the Selmon Expressway. The title of the project is as follows:

II. SCOPE OF WORK

01010 - SUMMARY OF WORK

1. DESCRIPTION

1.01 This section provides a general summary or overview of the work to be performed in the Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. O-02320. In performing the work, procedures of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Seven (Department) shall be adhered to.

Estimated pipe and structure quantities are provided for the Vendor's use in preparing the Bid Proposal Form (Exhibit C). The Vendor shall be responsible for the determination of final quantities.

I. OBJECTIVE

The Vendor shall perform Storm Drain Video Inspection for the Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority (Authority) in accordance with the procedures of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Seven (Department) as described in this Exhibit "A" Scope of Services. These duties include video inspection of storm drain pipes, manholes and inlets. The Vendor will also make recommendations for maintenance and repair of the existing system. The Vendor shall prepare evaluation/inspection reports utilizing Department prepared forms and submit them to the Authority for review.

These duties will be required for the identified storm drains on the Selmon Expressway between approximate Stations 685+00 to 723+00, and approximate Stations 5001+00 to 5033+00 as highlighted in blue on the included Reference Documents and Drawings.

II. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE VENDOR

The Vendor shall furnish all labor, transportation, equipment, maintenance of traffic and incidentals required to perform any of the following tasks in accordance with Florida Department of Transportation <u>Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction</u>, <u>July 2020</u>, and <u>Supplemental Specifications</u>.

A. <u>VIDEO REQUIREMENTS</u>

- 1. Provide video files via digital media (flash drive only) or by online digital distribution in Windows Media Video (WMV) format with a standard resolution of 720 x 480. Use a camera with lighting suitable to allow a clear picture of the entire periphery of the pipe. Center the camera in the pipe both vertically and horizontally and be able to pan and tilt to a 90-degree angle with the axis of the pipe and rotating 360 degrees. Use equipment that shall not obstruct the camera's view or interfere with proper documentation of the pipe's condition.
- 2. The video image shall be clear, focused, and relatively free from roll, static, or other image distortion qualities that would prevent the reviewer from evaluating the condition of the pipe. The video shall include identification before each section of pipe filmed. The identification shall include the project number, the structure number corresponding to the

- structure number on the set of plans for the project, size of pipe, the date and time, and indicate which pipe is being filmed if multiple pipes are connected to the structure. Notes shall be taken during the video recording process. Provide the Director of Operations and Engineering or designee with copies of these notes along with the video.
- 3. Move the camera through the pipe at a speed not greater than 30 feet per minute. Mark the video with the distance down the pipe. The distance shall have an accuracy of one foot per 100 feet. Film the entire circumference at each joint. Stop the camera and pan when necessary to document and measure defects. Position the camera head perpendicular to all defects requiring measurement by the video micrometer.
 - 4. Capture locations of manholes at beginning and end pipe runs using a Global Positioning System (GPS) data collection device with accuracy equal to or greater than two to five meters. Differential GPS correction may be conducted real-time if the GPS data collection device is integrated with a Satellite Based Augmentation System (SBAS) receiver, otherwise GPS data must be post-processed with differential correction software to meet the accuracy requirement. GPS data shall be geographically referenced by the State Plane FL West coordinate system and North American Datum of 1983, 2011 Adjustment (NAD83/2011) datum.
 - Solution Manhole locations shall be provided to the Authority in Environmental System Research Institute (ESRI) Geographic Information System (GIS) shapefile format. The shapefile shall be named "Manhole Locations" and contain Point Geometry features. The shapefile attribute table shall be formatted as shown in Table 1. Each manhole record shall be assigned the six digits of the Authority alpha-numeric project/contract/task order number. The dash in the project number shall be ignored. Manhole ID's shall be assigned according to manhole ID's on existing schematic drainage plans.

6. Run data shall be provided to the Authority in ESRI GIS shapefile format. Run data does not contain GPS coordinates. Rather, this data shall be generated in a desktop GIS application after field work is conducted. The shapefile will be named Run Video, contain Polyline geometry features, and be geographically referenced by the State Plane FL West coordinate system and NAD83/2011 datum. The shapefile attribute table shall be formatted as shown in Table 2. Run ID's shall be assigned by the Vendor. Manhole ID's shall correspond between the Manhole locations shapefile and the fields RUN_BEGIN and RUN_END in the Run Video attribute table.

B. VIDEO INSPECTION SERVICES

- 1. The subsurface video inspection shall include:
 - a. Providing Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) in accordance with FDOT rules, regulations and policies when needed (provide 20 working days minimum advance notification to the Authority and the FDOT local maintenance offices). Coordinate with local maintenance offices, county or local governments as required for implementation. All work and incidental costs specified as being covered under Section 102 of the FDOT Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction, July 2020 and Supplemental Specifications shall be included in the contract unit price for the work being performed and no separate payment will be made.
 - b. The Vendor is responsible for the design, approval, installation, and operation of an adequate dewatering system when necessary to perform video inspection services. Measurement shall be per each pipe segment (structure to structure) approved for dewatering. Payment shall be full compensation for all materials, labor and incidentals required to dewater each pipe section.
 - c. The vendor is responsible for cleaning the existing storm drain system of debris and silt (use high- pressure jetting and commercial vacuum services to desilt drainage pipes and structures) and dispose of debris.
 - d. Conducting inspection of culvert interior.
 - e. Documenting findings of damaged culverts including pipe cracks, joint gaps, and leaky joints.
 - f. Photographing all areas of damage observed.
 - g. Providing weekly progress report for active task work orders.
- 2. When a pipe segment or structure is inaccessible for video recording, the Vendor shall request that the Authority's Contract Manager notify the Authority's Asset Management contractor for assistance to access the storm drain.

- 3. The Vendor shall provide the Authority video files and reports using low barrel distortion video equipment with laser profile technology, non-contact video micrometer, and associated software that includes:
 - a. Actual recorded length and width measurements of all cracks within the pipe.
 - b. Actual recorded separation measurements of all rigid, plastic, and metal pipe joints.
 - c. Pipe deformation/deflections measurements, leaks, debris, or other damage or defects.
 - d. Deviation in pipeline and grade, joint gaps, and joint misalignment.
- 4. Laser profiling and measurement technology must be certified by the company Performing the work to be in compliance with the calibration criteria. Reports Submitted in electronic media are preferred.

C. VIDEO INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS

The Video Inspection Requirements shall include:

- 1. Video recording segmented pipe runs, and structures of the storm drain facility as depicted on schematic plans.
- 2. Provide video files of all segmented runs as described in Section II, A.1, 2 and 3.
- 3. Provide all GIS data and digital field photographs as described in Section II, A.,4,5 and 6.
- 4. A "Video Inspection Report Sheet" (See Attachment A, Example 1)
- 5. Photo logs of each segmented run (See Attachment A, Example 2)
- 6. Line inspection reports for every segmented run.

D. <u>VIDEO INSPECTION REPORT SHEET</u>

The Video Inspection Report Sheet shall include:

- 1. Session information: project name, project number, segment run number, date, time, location, and operator.
- 2. Pipe information: pipe size, type, length and existing conditions (comments and notes).
- 3. Structure information (from structure to structure) include structure number, type, depth, owner (THEA, FDOT, City, other) and existing conditions (comments and notes).

E. STORM DRAIN VIDEO INSPECTION AND DRAINAGE ASSESSMENT REPORT

1. The report shall be prepared in order to provide the Authority with a subsurface inspection and condition of the existing culverts within a specified limit. This work effort also includes an evaluation of the existing storm sewer pipe culverts for structural and functional integrity.

- 2. The Storm Drain Video Inspection data documentation shall include a "Storm Drain Video Inspection and Drainage Assessment Report" with the following:
 - a. Table of Contents
 - b. Schematic Plans (include plan sheets see Attachment A, Examples 3 5)
 - c. Summary (recommended storm drain repairs, include a comprehensive
 "Storm Drain Assessment Summary" spreadsheet (see Attachment A, Examples 6 –
 9).
 - Inspection Reports (include video inspection report sheets, photo logs, and line inspection reports).
 - e. Sample Storm Drain Video Inspection and Drainage Assessment Report are provided in Attachment A.
 - f. The Vendor shall submit the Storm Drainage Video Inspection and Drainage Assessment Report to the Authority for review and approval.

F. INITIAL INSPECTION REPORT

1. The Vendor shall provide to the Authority the results of the first inspection undertaken on this assignment along with the required reports, schematic plans, and recommendations in order to confirm compliance with the requirements contained herein. Proceed with remaining inspections only after receiving confirmation from the Authority that the Vendor's inspection and reporting methods are in compliance with the requirements contained herein.

III. AUTHORITY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Authority shall appoint a Contract Manager to administer the terms of this agreement. The Contract Manager will be Mr. Brian Pickard, P.E., Director of Operations and Engineering, or his designee, Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority, 1104 E. III. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. THEA must receive all submittals at the locations stated below, not later than 2:00 PM Eastern on 10/16/2020. Any submittal received after the stated time and date shall not be considered. It shall be the sole responsibility of the firm to have its package delivered to THEA by U.S. Mail, hand delivery, or any other method available to them; however, facsimile or telegraphic submittals will not be accepted. Delay in delivery shall not be the responsibility of THEA. Submittals received after the deadline shall not be considered and may be returned only at the firm's expense.
- 2. There is no Pre-Bid Meeting for this project.
- 3. Each firm shall examine all documents and shall determine all matters relating to the interpretation of such documents.
- 4. The following forms are required by THEA to be submitted as part of the Bid Proposal Package:

 - B ~ Drug-Free Workplace
 - C ~ Bid Proposal Forms
 - D ~ Anticipated SBE
 - E ~ Conflict of Interest

- 6. THEA shall not be liable for any expenses incurred in the preparation of the bid proposals.
- 7. THEA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bid proposals, to waive irregularities and technicalities, and to request resubmission or to re-advertise for all or any part of the work. THEA shall be the sole judge of the submittals and the resulting negotiated agreement that is in THEA's best interest, and THEA's decision shall be final.
- 8. Joint proposals will not be accepted.
- 9. The successful firm shall be required to execute an agreement, in form and content acceptable to THEA, indemnifying and holding harmless THEA, its officials, officers, employees, and agents from all claims.
- 10. Firms, their agents, or associates shall refrain from contacting or soliciting any THEA staff or members of the Board directly or indirectly regarding this ITB during the selection process. Failure to comply with this provision may result in the disqualification of the firm. All requests for clarification or additional information should be made in writing via email to: Man.Le@tampa-xway.com

IV. QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. The bidder must include with its proposal package all completed required forms as indicated in Section III Instructions to Bidders. Failure to submit all completed forms may be cause for rejection at the sole option of THEA.
- 2. Bidder must meet the following minimum qualifications:
 - a. Been actively engaged in the type of business being requested for a minimum of two years.
 - b. Ability to provide reports using Microsoft Word and Excel software
 - c. Has performed at least three projects within the past two years of no less than 1,000 linear feet of video inspection of storm drain pipes, manholes, and inlets; providing maintenance and repair recommendations; and repair deficiencies in the existing system. Project fees should be between \$5000.00 and \$500,000.00.
 - d. The bidder shall be certified in FDOT Temporary Traffic Control.
- 3. The bidder shall designate from its staff a fulltime, qualified Project Manager having at least 5 years of experience in performing and/or administering similar types of work as this project. The Project Manager shall be the single point of contact as liaison with THEA during the procurement process and during performance of the project. The Project Manager shall be the responsible person in charge of coordinating day to day work activities, schedules, payment applications, directing the firm's work forces, reports, day to day administrative matters, coordinating the SBE policy to achieve the established goals and other related items necessary to fulfill the requirements of the Contract.

V. SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process for this ITB will consist of the following.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Proposals will be evaluated on whether the bidder is responsible and responsive to this solicitation, with the objective to evaluate those bids and responses and to award a contract for the work to the **lowest total bid price**.

THEA will determine the responsive and responsible bidder, in its sole and absolute discretion, considering all relevant facts and information.

FINAL SELECTION:

The bidder with the **lowest total bid price** will be presented to THEA's Board for consideration and approval with a recommendation that the bidder be selected per the Schedule of Events below.
